CHAIR'S REPORT

Purpose

- 1. The purpose of this paper is to provide an update to the Board on activities and matters involving the Chair which are not covered by other papers on the agenda.
- 2. Annex A to the paper gives a full list of the meetings and events I have attended since the last Board meeting and I am happy to take any comments or questions on those. The main body of the paper highlights any particular points arising from my meetings which I think you should be aware of.

NHS Scotland change programme

3. Along with the Chief Executive, I attended a meeting of the Senior Leaders Forum (SLF) on the 22 February and by the time of our Board meeting I will have attended the monthly Board Chairs' meeting. There is a growing sense of impetus behind more regional planning and operation for the territorial boards, and similarly for more joint planning and shared services across the national boards. I will continue to make sure that the Board has the opportunity to discuss the implications for NHS Health Scotland.

Third sector collaboration

- 4. I attended The Gathering on the 23 February, an annual event organised by SCVO, spoke in a joint session with their acting Chief Executive and signed a Memorandum of Understanding with its Chair. I also attended a screening of the film "I, Daniel Blake" as part of Declaration 2017, an arts festival which we sponsor jointly with the Health and Social Care Alliance, the Mental Health Foundation, NHS Lothian and the University of Strathclyde. I took part in a panel discussion after the screening.
- 5. Both events were a reminder of the importance of the Third Sector in reaching the communities and groups of people most affected by poor health and health inequalities. We are already well aware of that and work hard to support and act alongside Third Sector and voluntary groups, but we will need to keep reinforcing it as planning for the new national public health body begins.
