- Housing Options (PREVENT1)


Health Data

- Mental Health (SMR04).
- Outpatients (SMR00)
- PIS Prescribing Information
- The Scottish Drugs Misuse Database (SMR24 and SMR25a)
- NRS Deaths





Timescales





The Cohorts

- Around 600k homelessness applications, containing 560k unique people
- Matched cohorts contain c 1.7 million from 20% least deprived and 20% most deprived (taken from across Scotland and not within LA).
- Study covers just under 2.2 million people.





Priorities

- Analysis of Homelessness data only, rather than PREVENT1
- For each health dataset, how many times have homeless people accessed the service compared with the cohorts.
- How many homeless people have complex needs. What's the relationship between this and repeat homelessness
- Aiming for initial findings by end Summer 2017.
