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What we do it



The journey to now

- Socially isolated housebound older people
- Made so by the built environment
- Older people more than other people
- People are complex and don't fit into boxes
- And we just keep on doing it, which is why a lot of services don't help people change





A menace to society

- 62 year old man, living in Websters Land (just off High Street, in central Edinburgh)
- 186 convictions for breach of the peace
- A man deemed by social services so aggressive he was risk assessed as being too dangerous for two people to work with
- About to be evicted for non-payment of rent and end up on street (having made himself deliberately homeless, according to the legislation)



And now, 12 years down the line





Not just older people

350 service users annually

60% reduction in	100% reduction
re-offending in	in social isolation
Follow Me service	across all services
90% improvement	50% reduction
in mental health	in alcohol abuse
across all services	in CARDS



How do we do it?



- ACCEPT, SUPPORT, INCLUDE
- ROWAN model
- Change is gradual, and has to come from the individual
