BOARD MEMBER NOTIFICATION OF STRATEGIC EXTERNAL EVENTS

Purpose

- 1. The purpose of this paper is to follow up the proposal included within the Stakeholder Engagement Plan (discussed by the Board on 24 March 2017) for keeping Board members appraised of opportunities to attend external events.
- 2. This is the first in a series of update papers which will be routinely included as a 'for noting' item on all future Board agendas. This paper provides some additional background information to what will be included in more routine updates in the future.
- 3. The paper asks the Board to note:
 - The current overview of external events already planned for 2017/18 where we anticipate high impact, high influence stakeholders being present (Appendix 1).
 - The process by which we will keep the Board updated on this list of events/
 - How we will support any Board member choosing to attend any of these events.

Background

- 4. The Board Development Plan approved by the Board on 17 February 2017 contains the following action for Board members in relation to the Board development domain of *Engaging with Stakeholders*, "Board members confidently fulfil their external Health Scotland ambassador role at events or as part of their own on-going business". This is so that Board Members can confidently articulate information about Health Scotland priorities and activities, so increasing its reputation and influence.
- 5. There are three milestones and measures in the Board Development Plan next to this activity:
 - i. Use of themes from Board sign off of 2017-22 A Fairer Healthier Scotland: A Strategic Framework for Action and Health Scotland's Delivery Plan 2017-18
 - ii. Use of weekly public affairs communications as appropriate
 - iii. Notification of any significant Health Scotland events and other events are communicated to Board members as appropriate
- 6. In addition to the areas outlined in paragraph 5 above, the Board has recently received a short briefing on Health Scotland key corporate messages, which has been updated with themes from the discussion at the 7 April Board Seminar.

- 7. As part of the Stakeholder Engagement Plan discussed with the Board on 24 March 2017, it was proposed that to support Board Members with their ambassadorial role at external events or conferences, the Board would receive for noting an update on upcoming strategic external events at each meeting. The detail of the process is outlined in the section below.
- 8. It is worth noting that this paper and process concern the ad hoc and informal ambassadorial role which is entirely at the discretion of any Board member depending on interest and availability. Specific requests for a non executive Board member to formally represent Health Scotland at an event or a meeting would normally come via the Chair. Specific briefings would be provided in those circumstances.

Notification of Events

- 9. A current overview of 2017/18 events offered by Health Scotland and other agencies highlighting those where high impact, high influence stakeholders is attached as Appendix 1. This overview will be updated and refreshed (with changes highlighted) for each Board meeting. It will be presented as a 'for noting' paper, and also updated to the extranet.
- 10. This will give Board members the opportunity to ask any questions or request further information. It will also be useful in indicating planned attendance as this may be of interest to other Board members.
- 11. Board members should notify the Executive and Governance Lead, in the first instance, if they would like to attend any of these events and if they feel they might require any specific support or background reading prior to doing so. This can be at the Board meeting itself, or separately.

Finance and Resource Implications

12. Where there is a cost associated for Board Members attending an event or meeting, this will met through the existing Board Member support processes and managed and monitored by the Executive and Governance team.

Staff Partnership

13. There are no specific staff partnership implications.

Communication and engagement

14. The process outlined in this paper feeds directly into the NHS Scotland Stakeholder Engagement plan, contributing to supporting Board Members fulfil their role as outlined in the plan to promote and position NHS Health Scotland in a way that is consistent with our key messages and with furthering our strategic engagement priorities with high influence, high impact stakeholders.

Corporate Risk

15. This process will contribute to mitigating corporate risk 7 "As a result of ineffective engagement with high influence and interest stakeholders we do not articulate our new strategic ambitions effectively and do not secure a national leadership position for reducing health inequalities".
