How we engaged with the third sector






Very quick history lesson!

- 2 year funding from Edinburgh and Lothian Health Foundation
 - Year 1: fieldwork, gathering evidence, speaking to staff and those who use services
 - Year 2: producing the guidance document, support materials, website and launch event
- Year 3: implementing the guidance in Lothians, developing training, national roll out plan





How did we find services?



- They come in all shapes and sizes
- They can be quite hidden
- They can be a smaller project inside a larger organisation
- You think you might know the sector, but you only know what you can see
- You might have to look quite hard to find them all
- They can disappear



How did we find services?


- In Year 1: fieldwork
 - Website trawl
 - ALISS (A Local Information System for Scotland)
 www.aliss.org
 - Third sector interfaces
 - Third sector partners and networks
 - Word of mouth
- Resulted in finding over 60 services for Edinburgh and Lothians alone
- But there were more to find in Year 3!!

IMPACT Training


- Smoking and mental health: understanding the IMPACT

- Will be available across Scotland from next year


