Context

- ❑ Colleagues from both sectors should seek public health representation in key strategic forums and planning processes, in order to maximise the potential contribution of good housing to improving health and reducing inequalities.
- ❑ Public health teams should also consider the contribution good housing can make to local priority areas identified through Community Planning, and how this contribution can be embedded into Local Outcome Improvement Plans and locality plans.

- Provides an overview of the housing strategies or plans that Local Authorities produce
 - Highlights opportunities for public health to engage in order to maximise the contribution that these plans and strategies can make to good health and reduced health inequalities

Local authority housing strategies dataset

A searchable database of Local Authority strategies and plans.

Contains details of strategies and plans published by each Local Authority as of August 2018 including:

- Local Development Plan
- Local Housing Strategy
- Strategic Housing Investment Plan

Search returns include:

- Dates the strategies and plans cover
- Links to each plan and strategy
- Whether the LA is part of a Strategic Development Planning Authority
- Which NHS Board operates in the LA area
