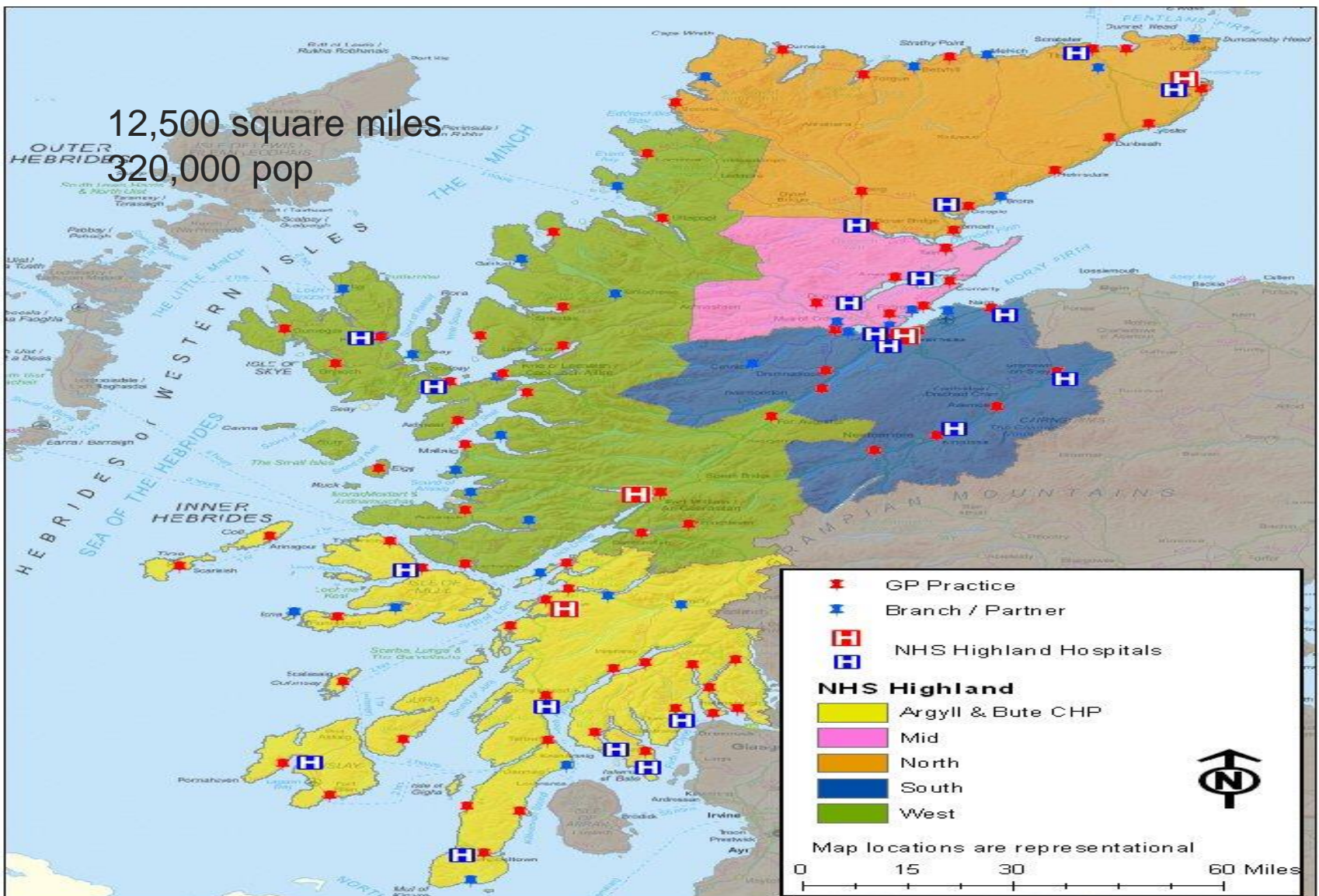

NHS Highland Hospital locations and GP Practices

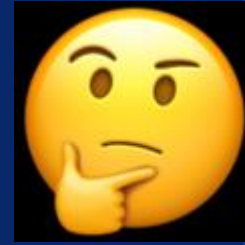

Stretch Aim

What are we aiming to achieve?

Develop children (0 – 5yrs years) immunisation delivery model including 2-5yrs flu

Primary Drivers

Allocate protected immunisation time

- Identify appropriate accommodation
- Identify most suitable daytime for running immunisation clinics
- Agree immunisation checklist and protocol
- Scheduling clinics with CHSP and SIRS
- Vaccine storage guidance/ Vaccine order
- Process to maintain cold chain
- Collate baseline data - Consider PDSA tests
- Equality Impact Assessment
- Engage GPs - set up meeting with GPs + Practice managers/social media
- Discuss test with parents at current clinics
- Immunisations flyers/ highlight positive factors for families
- Meet with relevant staff nurses to explain test
- Direct staff nurses to undertake immunisation module through PDP
- Draw up staff training schedule
- Draw up staff rota

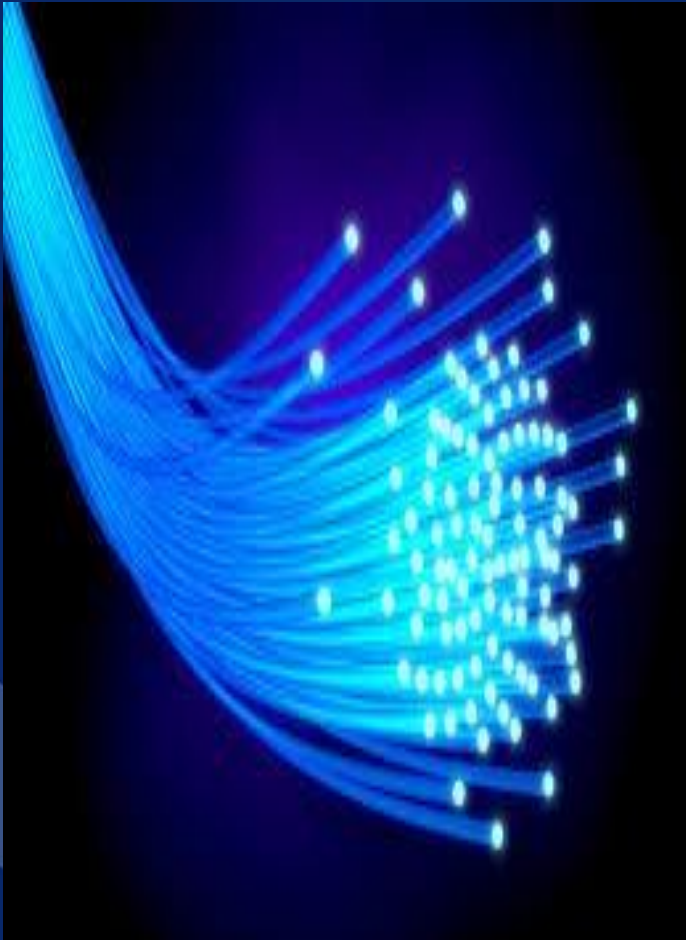


Highland Challenges

- VTP has been placed in year 3 of PCIP (North Highland)
- North Highland Lead Agency Model
- Resources e.g. accommodation, staffing , cost

Achievements

- Embedded Team in Helensburgh delivering 0-18yrs in a centralised clinic and school programme
- Pilot on Isle of Mull centralising the 0-5yrs service with delivery in community hospital.
- TOC in Dunoon delivering 0-5yrs through an ITR is underway
- Midwifery colleagues working towards delivery of Pertussis and Flu by September 2019

Next steps for year 2

- Helensburgh Team TOC adding in 2-5yrs flu vaccination 2019/20
- Oban and Dunoon TOC for 65 yrs and over flu delivery and first time eligible for pneumococcal
- Lochaber area TOC for 0-5yrs programme
- Local IT solutions being sought

VTP opportunities

- Potential for flexibility for the public through an immunisation service
- Potential for timeous immunisations
- Streamlining of services for hard to reach groups e.g. travelling communities, children in residential care
